Topic: The Genus Cattleya in Brazil

Miranda Orchids started in 1999 and is a nursery specializing in growing mainly selected Cattleya alliance species. In a sense, it is a continuation of Boa Vista Orchids, a nursery we ran in Brazil from 1986 until we moved to the U.S.A. Many of the plants available are produced in our lab and



nursery in Central Florida from our extensive collection of stud plants. The rest we bring from Brazil to increase variety and novelty. Being native Brazilians, and having had a nursery for many years, we know that there is a lot of development in Cattleya species being done there. This is mostly because a lot of those species are native from Brazil (including all the bifoliate cattleyas) and because these plants are favorites of growers there. Of course having lived and grown orchids for a long time there we know most of the growers and what is being produced and we go there several times a year to make sure we are kept up-to-date. Miranda Orchids also grows other Brazilian species so if you are looking for something in particular do not hesitate to contact us. Our goal is to be your number one source for selected Brazilian Orchids.




















# **January Growers Clinic**

# VAOS ANNUAL SHOW INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL SHOW VOLUNTEERS

Thank you for volunteering for our annual show!

All volunteers must enter through the rear door. A volunteer by the kitchen will verify your assignment from our list and provide directions. Pick up your nametag there and then pick up your t-shirt at the membership table before you report to your work location.

Volunteers are requested to park at the back of parking lots on both sides of building. No parking is permitted behind the building – loading and unloading only.

All show volunteers receive a show t-shirt and free admission to the show. Food donations should also be brought in through the rear door by 11am each day. Those members receive free admission to the show. All others must enter through the front door Saturday and Sunday and pay admission.

The Venice Community Center has strict rules regarding loading and unloading. All show participants may use only the three rear steel doors for loading and unloading – no exceptions! Nothing may be brought in through the lobby or the side glass doors.

All communications with the VCC staff and our show vendors should be through Carol, Judy or Ed Soentgen (to avoid any miscommunications)

Your committee chair will have instructions for your assignment when you arrive. Please review them.

Show attendees are our guests and we are famous for our army of friendly volunteers. Greet our guests with a smile!

### OTHER SHOW INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS

**ORCHID BOUTIQUE GREENERY -** The Orchid Boutique team requests greenery from members for their floral arrangements.

- •Hardy, long-lasting greens such as: mini palm fronds, croton, ti, and ginger leaves, all kinds of ferns, ivy, papyrus stems. If you think something is interesting or **colorful** please bring it in. A handful of <u>Short to Medium</u> stalks work best, as most containers are 12" or less.
- Please drop off your items on **Friday, January 31st** from 9:00 4:00 or **Saturday** from 9:00 to noon. Enter the back doors by the kitchen. Orchid Boutique is across from the kitchen. The foliage should be in a container--bucket, gallon milk jug, plastic cup, etc. -- that has some water in it. Any container with a name on it will be returned to you.

# VAOS 2020 SHOW HOST PROCEDURES PLEASE READ

Show Hosts are stationed at most entrances to the Venice Community Center to 1) prevent unauthorized entrance or exit, 2) prevent theft and 3) prevent attendees from stepping into displays or touching flowers in the displays.

Show hosts will be stationed at:

- S1 Front left side entrance
- S2 Rear left side entrance
- S3 Rear main entrance where most unloading takes place
- S4 Rear ballroom entrance
- S5 and S6 Stage area side doors
- S7 Lobby (Ed Soentgen)

The Show Host Committee Chair(s) Sharon & John Kahnoski will also cover these stations as needed. Any extra volunteers from other committees will be detailed to monitor an entrance station or "rove" the display area.

Most building doors will remain unlocked for fire safety reasons.

Stanchions will be placed in front of ballroom doors not monitored to discourage exit.

Chairs will be provided for show host volunteers at doors.

Show host volunteers posted at doors should also monitor the displays.

Show vendors have been requested to place sold plants and items in bags to help us with security.

Only VAOS members who have volunteered their time to work the show or who have brought in food to the kitchen for the show will receive free admission.

**Volunteers must use the rear entrance to the building.** Show staff at the Rear Entrance will have a list of all volunteers by their committee assignment.

Pick up your name badge and Show Host badge at the rear door.

Pick up your t-shirt at the Membership Table before reporting to your assigned work location. Only VAOS members who have volunteered their time to work **the show will receive t-shirts.** 

Return your Show Host badge to your replacement or to the Show Host Committee Chair at the rear door at the completion of your shift.

Members trying to enter through the Rear Entrance who are not on the volunteer list or who are not delivering food to the kitchen should be directed to the front lobby entrance and will have to pay admission.

Member volunteers who worked Friday set up should enter through the rear entrance and their names will be on the volunteer list for Show Set Up.

The Show Host Committee Chair will have a diagram and list of volunteer assignments for each time segment during the show (Friday p.m., Saturday a.m., mid-day and p.m. and Sunday a.m., mid-day and p.m.) Show host volunteers should report to the Committee Chair for assignment.

Show host volunteers should avoid altercations but should politely and firmly direct people to the correct entrance, the correct exit, or back to the vendor to obtain a bag for a sold item.

Be friendly and answer questions people may have and please do not wander away from your post.

Show attendees may not step into orchid displays to take photos. Tri-pods are not permitted. Children need to be under parents' control. Help prevent attendees from touching flowers (oil on skin will damage blossoms)

All security volunteers should wear their show t-shirt, distributed at the Membership Table upon their arrival.

Our first orchid show of the season, the annual Sarasota Orchid Society (SOS) Show and Sale. Show hours are Saturday 9am - 5pm and Sunday 10am -5pm. Setup is Friday, January 3rd, 2020, 9am - 5pm.

Your blooming plants are needed to create our display. We will collect and transport your plants to the show and ensure their safe return to you on Monday following the show. Bring your plants to one of two locations by Thursday January 2<sup>nd</sup> no later than 6pm:

South Venice: Carol Wood, 4941 Bella Terra Dr., Venice (Venetia), 497-4995 (Leave on front porch)

Venice Island: Bruce Weaver, 328 West Bay Dr., Venice, 800-7804 (leave by front door)

Or bring them to the Sarasota Municipal Auditorium on Friday January 3<sup>rd</sup> at 9am

All plants must be registered in advance via email by Wednesday, January 1st, 8pm:

Email your plant name with a photo or bloom size and color description to <a href="mailto:PlantReg@VAOS.org">PlantReg@VAOS.org</a>.

Plants should be cleaned, staked, free of pests and disease and labeled with both the plant name and the owner's name. Flowers should be in prime condition to last through the weekend show. Please water your plants thoroughly and place in a box or container for transport to the show.

We need help transporting plants and with display set up on Friday and take down on Sunday. If you can help, please contact Jay Loeffler at 485-9569

# **Preparing Your Orchid for the Show Exhibit**

#### **Groom Your Plant:**

- Remove dead or brown leaves and pseudobulbs from the plant. Clean the pseudobulbs and leaves (water helps to soften the dry papery covering around pseudobulbs so that you can gently rub it off). Trim dead areas from leaves. Cut following the basic shape of the natural leaf ending if possible.
- Wipe the top of the leaves (vinegar, lemon juice, sprite, 7 up, etc.) to remove residue. Do not use commercial spray to shine the leaves.
- Make sure the media in the container is clean. Remove trash, debris, dead leaves or stems and weeds from the pot.

### Pests or Diseases:

While prepping orchids for a display, check for pests and disease. Check the leaves and pseudobulbs for a white cottony substance, an indication of mealybugs. Hard, whitish bumps may mean scale and if any are found remove them with alcohol and a Q-tip. If there is a bad infestation, do not bring the plant to the show. Check for other pests such as snails, slugs and ants. Inspect the flowers for thrips and other damage. If a flower is marred by the spots it is better to leave the plant at home.

### Stakes:

- Carefully stake the spike that will present the flowers to their best advantage. If you can plan
  ahead of time, it is best to stake the spike as it emerges; an older spike is harder and can break
  off easier.
- These are often needed to support the flower spike but should not distract the eye. Keep them looking as natural as possible. Stakes should not protrude beyond the top of the last bloom flower, but should allow the flowers to be kept away from the foliage. It may also protect the flower spike from damage during travel to the show.
- Remove any wire hangers, hoops, etc. Water each plant thoroughly before bringing to the show. If the plant is in a plastic pot, drop it into a clay pot for stability. Place each plant carefully in a large box or container for transport. To keep the plants from moving around you can put rolled newspapers around the pots.

#### Labels:

Take a piece of masking tape, write your name on it and tape it to the side of pot. This is how the Team knows the proper plant owner so it will be returned to you.

Your blooming plants are needed to create our winning displays. We can collect and transport your plants to the show and ensure their safe return to you following the show.
