Laelia purpurata striata / venosa divisions



'Austin Creek' – \$50 – a very nice selection from a noted nursery in Northern California with a light blush to petals and 4-5 flowers per infl.



'Candy Cane' HCC/AOS – \$150 – almost a semi-alba, with just a touch of color in the petals, this monster has nearly 8" wide flowers and wonderful form; this is a rarely offered division of the awarded plant.



'Blushing Beauty' – \$150 – huge, 7"+ flowers, 4-5 per stem, and excellent form makes this an awardable and exceptional clone; its color is almost a tipo, but for some stripes in the petals.

Laelia purpurata sanguinea divisions



'Hot Nights' AM/AOS – \$200 – one of the highest awarded sanguineas with great color and shape, and also wonderfully vigorous; one of the best plants on this list!



'DD282' – \$100 – very large segments, and excellent petal color, but a wide white stripe in the dorsal separates this from 'Hot Nights', but a vigorous grower with very wide petals.



'Bev' – \$80 – an exceptionally large, flat lip on this clone, but somewhat lighter in color than the other two on this page.

Laelia purpurata alba / concolor divisions



'Concolor #1' – \$100 – great chance to get a very rare color form, with a beautiful, delicate pink blush on the entire flower; from the selfing of the awarded concolor 'Taguara' AM/AOS.



'Taguara' AM/AOS – \$200 – the original awarded concolor, this one has great depth of color, and is a wonderful, vigorous grower with 5 flowers per inflorescence...choice!



'Chardonnay' – \$80 – a beautiful true alba, this clone has great form for its type, and also typically carries 5 flowers per inflorescence, a trait rare in albino forms.

Laelia purpurata semi-alba divisions



'No. 24' – \$60 – a solid semi-alba collected clone with good depth of color, high flower count, and very vigorous habit; the petal width and form of this flower would preclude an award, but it's a good specimen grower.



'No. 222' – \$50 – a solid semi-alba collected clone with good depth of color, high flower count, and very vigorous habit; the petal width and form of this flower would preclude an award, but it's a good specimen grower.



'J.G. #2' HCC/AOS - \$150 - one of the very best atropurpurea forms, with dark color all the way to the center of the flower; this clone comes originally from noted grower Jerry Rodder.



Laelia purpurata roxo-violeta / aco divisions



'Palco 400' – \$100 – imported from Brazil as a selected clone, this roxo-violeta has very large flowers with nice shape and high count, typically with 5 flowers per inflorescence.



'Rocky Road' – \$80 – excellent flower size with a deeply contrasting lip make this an excellent clone.



'Schusteriana' HCC/AOS– \$80 – the original award to this color form, this clone still has excellent shape and dark, vivid color.

Laelia purpurata carnea divisions (and one more)



'Lady Godiva' HCC/AOS – \$100 – despite being an older award, this russeliana is still amongst the best in shape, has beautiful light color and is a vigorous grower in addition



'Rosy Maria' – \$60 – very dark for a russeliana, this nice wide-petaled clone almost passes for the new designation of "cereja" or cherry-colored; has a good inflorescence with 4-5 flowers.



'Genesio Rocks' – \$200 – another aco clone from Brazil, this was imported after seeing it in bloom at a purpurata show; it has exceptional shape, with very wide petals, and has an oculate type lip.

Plants are growing vigorously in 6" pots. Shipping via USPS Priority, bare-root with the roots wrapped in moss is \$20 for the first plant, \$5 per additional plant.
