## **Venice Area Orchid Society Meeting Minutes**

#### **Date: April 5, 2023**

Joanna Shaw called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. She welcomed all members and explained the process of our meeting. She drew attention to the plant table, encouraging everyone to vote for their favorite orchid. Joanna encouraged members to check out the Raffle Table. One of the prizes is two tickets for a special event at the Redland Show; tickets are valued at \$60 each. Joanna presented a change for the use of name tags. Members will take name tags home and keep them to wear at the next meeting. Paper nametags are available at the desk.

Announcements: Joanna welcomed Rick Belisle, Director of Education and Coordinator of the Mentor Program, to the podium. Rick explained the Mentor Program was created by Peggy Fahrenback during 2012 to help newer growers learn more about orchids. Each Mentor is a member who is comfortable with growing orchids. A Mentee is a beginning grower, or one who is having an issue with growing orchids. Mentees are expected to attend at least two Growers Clinics before applying. VAOS is one of only four orchid growing clubs in Florida that have a Mentor program. Each Mentee is assigned to a Mentor; together they enjoy learning about and appreciating orchids. One hundred VAOS members have graduated from the program. Currently we have 9 VAOS mentees. Our Mentors are: Carol Wood, Ed Murphy, Steve Vogelhaupt, Steve Wiener, Tony Nacinovich Ian Kennedy, Jimmy Thomas, Don Smart, Gunther Lobisch. and Rick Belisle. Applications for both Mentors and Mentees are available at the desk and on the VAOS website. We need more Mentors for the program.

Rick introduced 5 graduating Mentees, Peg Yoder, Eva Holtzer, Diane & Pat Kearney and Mike Mayers, calling them to the front of the auditorium for graduation. Each Mentee was proudly honored with VAOS pins, given as a symbol of graduation.

Joanna announced there will be a VAOS Plant Sale on April 29 at Blalock Park in Venice. Hours are from 9am to 12 noon. Orchids, orchid supplies and other plants may be sold. Participants bring their own tables and chairs. Please notify Denise Langman if you plan to have a table for selling. Printed information is available at the back table.

Judy Loeffler discussed plans for the February, 2024 VAOS Orchid Show. The theme will be "Peace Love Orchids." Participants may dress in 1960's attire, having fun wearing poodle skirts, bell bottom pants, etc. Judy said many volunteers will be needed for the Show.

## Annual Meeting and Election of VAOS Directors

Joanna Shaw led the annual meeting and election. She introduced and thanked the outgoing officers for their contributions to VAOS: Sue Grimmer (Membership), Sharon Kahnoski (VP Social) and Kathryn Jeske (Recording Secretary). Enthusiastic applause erupted. Joanna presented the nominees for each of these positions: Karen Kennedy, Ian Kennedy (Membership), Denise Langman (VP Social), and Peggy Fahrenback (Recording Secretary). Members unanimously voted for all nominees to be directors and applauded.

Vicki Fisher introduced tonight's speaker Ti, of Florida Orchid House in Myakka City, FL. Ti and her husband Henry began growing orchids as a hobby, but it eventually became a business. Their goal is to grow exotic beautiful plants that are accessible to both hobbyists and growers across the country. Their topic was Soft Cane Dendrobiums. Henry brought a huge, beautiful soft cane Dendrobium orchid to display as an example.
