

Your Blooming Plants Are Needed!

Sarasota Orchid Society Show

Our first orchid show of the 2025 season, the annual Sarasota Orchid Society Show and Sale.

Plant Registration: Sunday, December 29th – Wednesday, January 1st

Set up: Friday January 3rd, 10am - 4pm

Show: Saturday January 4th, 9am – 5pm and Sunday January 5th, 10am – 4pm

Take Down: Sunday January 5th, 4pm

Location: Sarasota Municipal Auditorium: 801 N. Tamiami Trail Sarasota

Your blooming plants are needed to create our display. We will collect and transport your plants to the show and ensure their safe return to you on Monday following the show.

Drop them off by Thursday January 2nd by 5pm: Kristin Shaw, 1541 Poinciana Rd., Venice, 484-707-8674 (South Venice)

Or call Kristin to arrange pickup 484-707-8674

Or bring them to the Sarasota Municipal Auditorium on Friday January 3rd before 10am

All plants must be registered in advance via email between Sunday December 29th and Wednesday January 1st

Email your plant name with a photo or bloom size and color description to PlantReg@VAOS.org.

Look for a return email confirming your plant registration with a number to attach to your plant. This will facilitate display set up at the show.

Plants should be cleaned, staked, free of pests and disease

Plants should be labeled with the plant name, the owner's name and the plant registration number provided when you register your plant

Flowers should be in prime condition to last through the weekend show. Please water your plants thoroughly and place in a box or container for transport to the show.

Volunteers are needed to transport plants and display materials to and from the Sarasota Show and to help with our display. To volunteer please contact:

Monthly Quick Tip from Your Growers Clinic Team



JANUARY

- Light Watering should be done in the morning hours.
- · Keep plants on the dry side.
- · Be prepared for cold protection.
- Spray for mites, then spray again in 7-10 days.



And, of course, cleaning up your growing area and plants by removing dead leaves helps to keep your plants healthy. This should be done throughout the year as needed.

VAOS SHOW ARTS & CRAFTS EXHIBIT – HOW TO ENTER

The Arts & Crafts Exhibit is a popular component of our annual show. Members may enter and display their orchid – related artwork and crafts for AOS judging and awards. Every year we invite our members and members of other participating orchid societies to display their artwork. The categories include:

Needlework

Painting - Oils

Painting - Acrylics

Painting – Watercolors

Sculpture

Ceramics

Jewelry

Photography (includes digital modifications)

Printing

Other



<u>The rules</u>: Orchids must be the dominant subject of all items submitted. Each item should be properly prepared for exhibition (framed, mounted, etc.). Contributors must be members of VAOS or a member of an orchid society participating in this show. Submissions will be screened prior to display and trophy or ribbons may be awarded at the judges' discretion. Art pieces previously winning prizes at a VAOS show are welcome to be displayed in exhibit but will not be judged. Judges may redefine classes based on entries submitted.

<u>How to Enter</u>: Bring your artwork to the community center on Friday, January 31st between 1pm and 3pm. Enter through the rear door, check in, and proceed to the left side of the stage. Arts & Crafts staff will assist you in registering your artwork.

Don't forget to bring easels or display stands, labeled with your name, if required for display.

You may enter up to three (3) items

VAOS Show Hosts will be stationed nearby to discourage our guests from touching the artwork.

Items may be sold but may not be removed from the display until the end of the show on Sunday. Pick up your artwork at 4pm on Sunday.
