

What type of **MEDIA** will be used?

The answers to these questions will guide you to selecting the best materials and process which, ultimately, will lead to a happy, healthy plant and satisfied grower!

April Culture Tip

Cymbidium

Those of us with Cymbidiums have plants that should be putting on a spectacular show. Adjust all staking and twist-ties and be on the lookout for aphids, slugs and snails. Give adequate water because flowering strains the plants. As new growths appear later, increase the nitrogen level in the fertilizer. Should a plant look healthy but not be blooming, try increasing the light during the next growing season. The number-one reason for no flowers in this wonderful genus is lack of light.









APRIL

- Repotting of large collections continues.
- Water heavily and well.
- Don't forget to fertilize!
- Spray for Thrips, and watch for mites.

And, of course, cleaning up your growing area and plants by removing dead leaves helps keep your plants healthy. This should be done throughout the year as needed.

APRIL GROWERS CLINIC - HANDS ON REPOTTING CLINIC

The April Growers Clinic will have our <u>Orchid ER</u>, as usual. Members and guests can bring in their problem plants and the team will diagnose and make suggestions as to how you should proceed. Attendees always hear new and important information for their own knowledge! This month we have a VERY special Growers Clinic! **Jim Roberts**, from **Florida SunCoast Orchids**, and one of our popular VAOS Show & Sale vendors, will be our Special Guest Speaker! Jim's presentation will focus on our popular <u>Demonstration of Dividing and Repotting an Orchid</u>. Shown will be potting in different types of media including bark, LECA, Lava rock and coconut husks. Jim and the Growers Clinic Team will explain the supplies, tools and planting media, demonstrate basic procedures, and share their tips of the trade. Jim will also have a selection of plants for sale. Then the **REAL** fun starts!

Participants will re-pot their own orchid with the assistance of several experienced growers and helpers. We will work in teams of 4 or 5 around a table with each person bringing an orchid that needs repotting as well as a suitable pot to replant the orchid and a sterile pair of shears. With only two hours available and a large turnout expected, it is critical that everyone adhere to the instructions below:

• <u>All plants must be removed from their pot and all old planting media and dead roots must be removed prior to the clinic</u>

- * Only one plant per person
- Bring your pot and shears
- Please make sure your plant is free from pests or diseases.

Media and supplies for most orchids will be provided. Members should remember to wear their VAOS Name Tags, please. There will be a Sign-in Sheet for guests. The meeting starts at 7:00PM and is held in Room F of the Venice Community Center. Park on the left (south) side of the building and enter through the side door.

Come early! Join us for a social hour 6-7pm prior to the growers clinic.



Please join us for our member orchid growing area tour on May 3, 2025.

If you are interested in showing other members your growing spaces/greenhouses, contact Denise at Social@vaos.org, no later than April 21, 2025, 2025 to be included as a tour stop. Any member is eligible to "Show Them Where You Grow Them".

Once all members are signed up, a tour guide will be released via email with directions to each location and times to view the growing areas, Members can then tour the areas at their leisure during the specified times. Visit one or all during the tour.

The tour is free and member guests are welcome.
